

MINNEAPOLIS AQUATENNIAL SENIOR AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The Minneapolis Aquatennial is a volunteer-driven organization that recognizes the value and importance of our community's senior volunteers. Each year the Aquatennial asks senior Organizations and businesses from around the Twin Cities to encourage seniors who may have an interest in serving as an Aquatennial Senior Ambassador to apply.

It is not too early to start thinking about nominating an individual or for that matter, please nominate yourself. Candidates need only be 55 years of age or older, has experience as a volunteer and is interested in serving as an Aquatennial Senior Ambassador. Fill out the attached nomination form and return to the address listed on the bottom of the nomination form. Deadline is May 15th. It's that easy.

The candidates will be invited to an orientation where they will be advised on all duties and expectations, if they are chosen. We welcome questions at this time. During the Aquatennial celebration in July, an experienced selection committee consisting of 3 to 5 members will select a Senior Ambassador court of 2 or 4 depending on the number of candidates interested and qualifying. The seniors who are selected will represent the Minneapolis Aquatennial as Senior Ambassadors for one year. They will participate in special events, visit many local communities, appear in parades and promote Aquatennial throughout the state. During their year-long reign they must also be available to sing with the senior singers.

All candidates who have participated in the selection process are invited to join the Senior Alumni Association. There is also an option being part of the Senior Singers who visit senior centers, nursing homes, and other venues for singing engagements. The honor of serving as a Senior Ambassador never fades.
